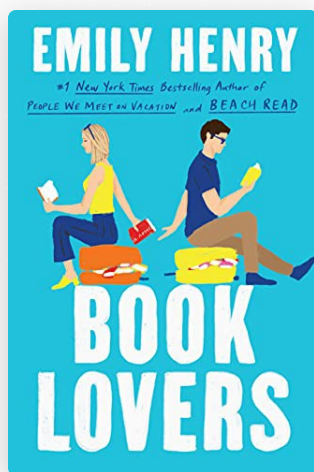

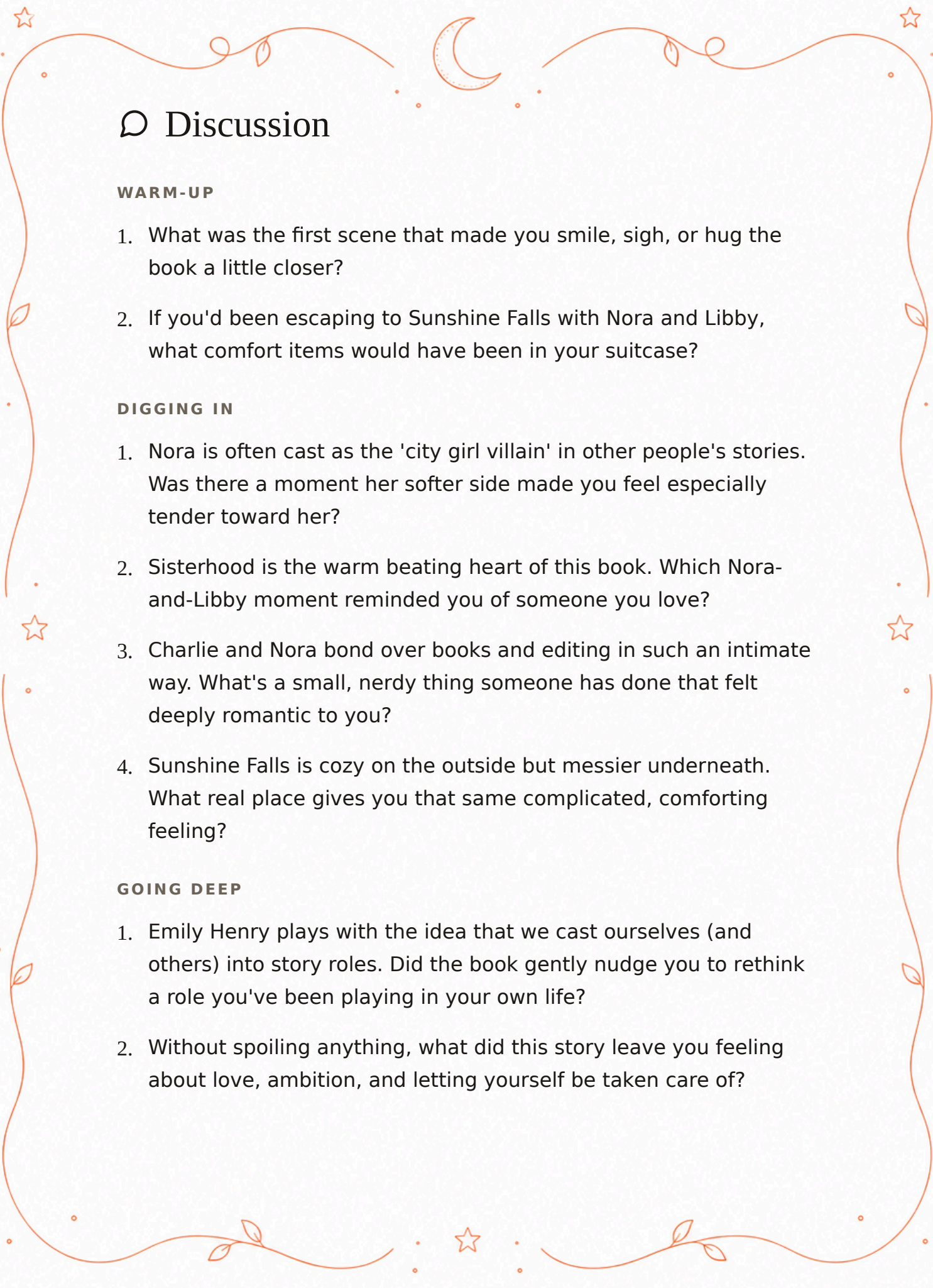
Sweaters, Snacks, and Sunshine Falls

WARM-UP

1. What was the first scene that made you smile, sigh, or hug the book a little closer?
2. If you'd been escaping to Sunshine Falls with Nora and Libby, what comfort items would have been in your suitcase?

DIGGING IN

1. Nora is often cast as the 'city girl villain' in other people's stories. Was there a moment her softer side made you feel especially tender toward her?
2. Sisterhood is the warm beating heart of this book. Which Nora-and-Libby moment reminded you of someone you love?
3. Charlie and Nora bond over books and editing in such an intimate way. What's a small, nerdy thing someone has done that felt deeply romantic to you?
4. Sunshine Falls is cozy on the outside but messier underneath. What real place gives you that same complicated, comforting feeling?

GOING DEEP

1. Emily Henry plays with the idea that we cast ourselves (and others) into story roles. Did the book gently nudge you to rethink a role you've been playing in your own life?
2. Without spoiling anything, what did this story leave you feeling about love, ambition, and letting yourself be taken care of?

Run of show

7:00

Soft landing

Greet guests with slippers-welcome energy, hand out warm drinks, let the playlist set the porch-light mood

7:15

Cozy graze

Open the grilled cheese bar and pot pie, encourage everyone to plate up and nestle into couches

7:35

Warm-ups

Ease in with the two warm-up questions while people are still eating, no pressure to be profound

8:00

Heart of the chat

Move into the theme questions, pass cookies around, let tangents happen

8:40

Deeper sips

Refill mugs, dim the lights a touch, and slow into the two deep questions

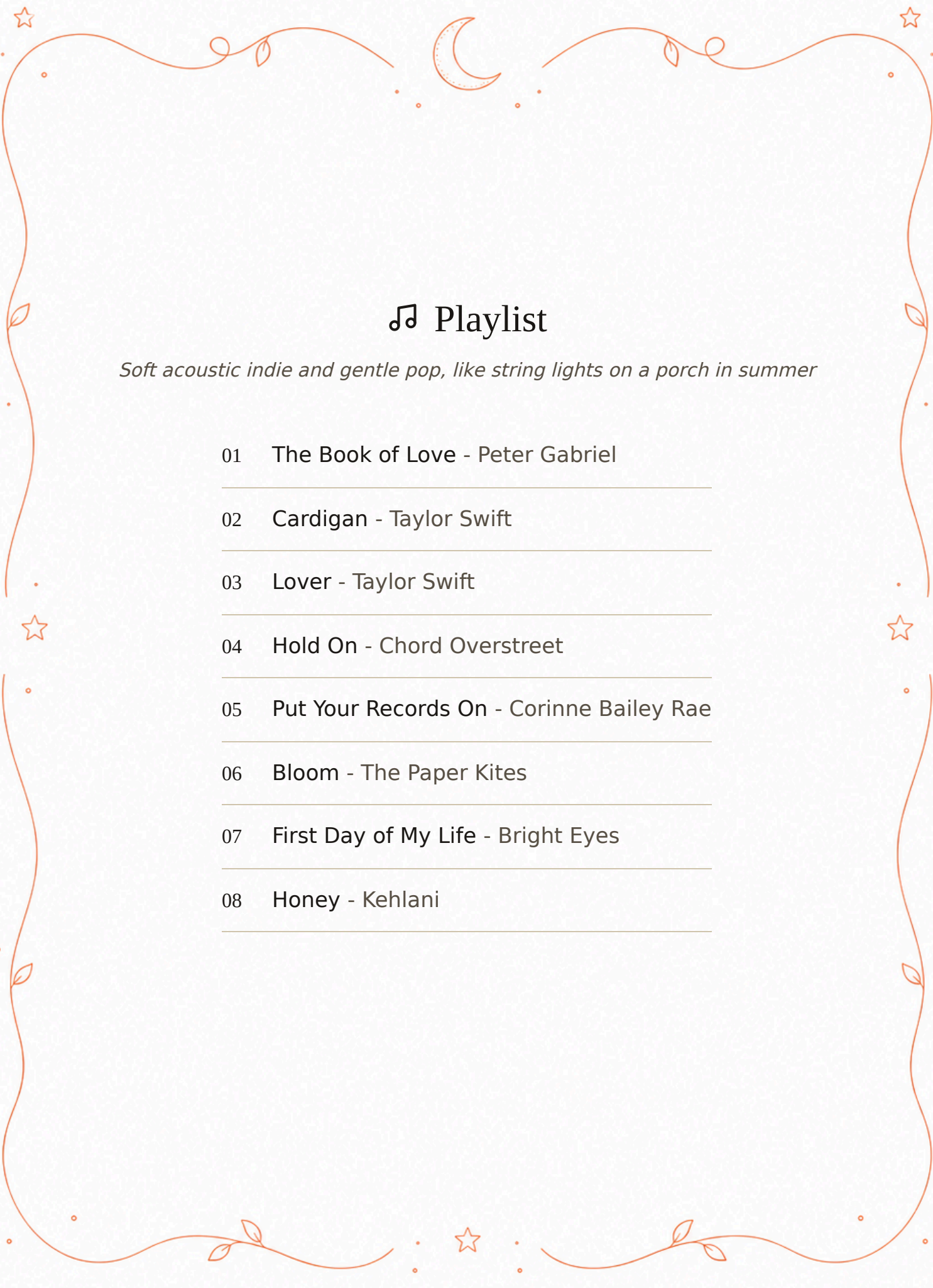
9:10

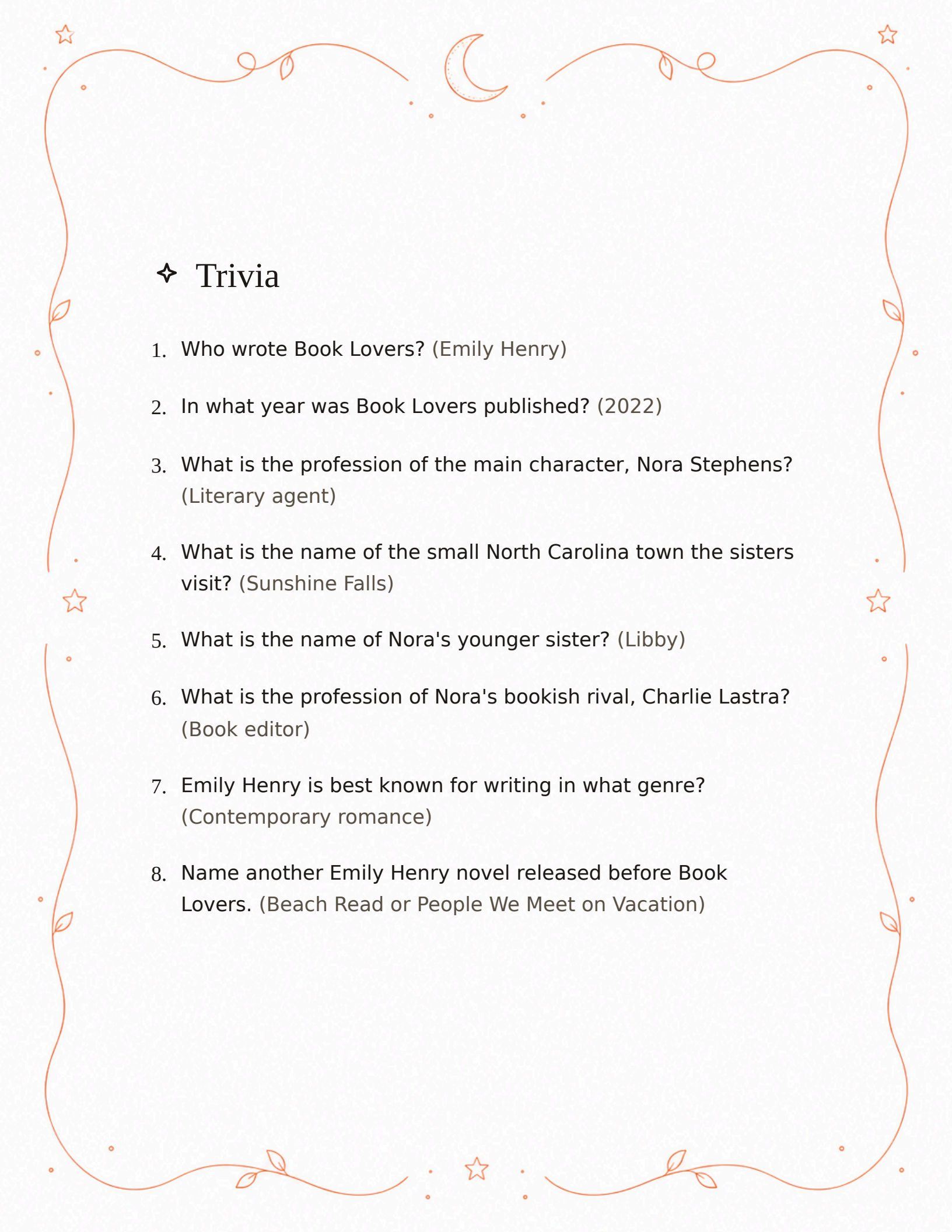
