How did the book's pacing feel to you? Was its slow, dreamy rhythm soothing, or did you want it to move faster, and what does that say about how you like to read?

Many characters are quietly shaped by promises made long before they understood the cost. Was there a moment that made you think about commitments in your own life and how you carry them?

By the last page, what feeling did the book leave you sitting with, and is there a memory or season of your own life it gently brought back?

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
